




It is a work of deep melancholy that also illuminates other characteristic features that make Debussy work separate from others: a sense of imagination, freedom and affective depth.. The songs alone can be enjoyed by each player; The challenges for performing artists are therefore to make an artistic statement that does not interfere with the organic nature of the work..
